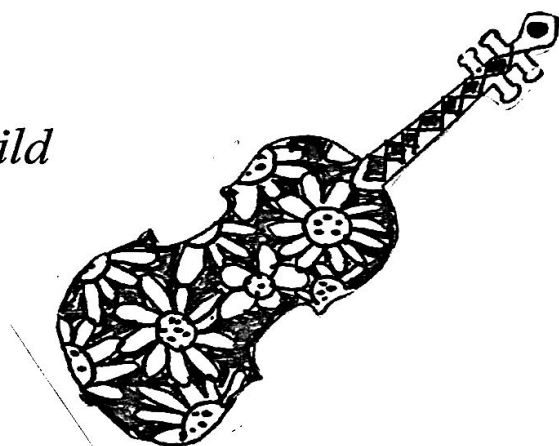

The Symphony Orchestra (HSO) and the Huntsville Symphony Orchestra Guild (HSOG) are proud to present the 54th annual Young Peoples' Concert in the Mark C. Smith Concert Hall on February 24 & 25, 2022. Gregory Vajda, HSO Music Director and Conductor will lead orchestra members in a performance of *Smitten with Britten, Children's Guide to the Symphony*. To enhance their interactive concert experience, we invite your fourth grade students to participate in the **Young Peoples' Concert Cover Art Contest**.

The students' artwork should be a decorated violin. The winning artwork will appear on the cover of the YPC booklet that students receive prior to attending the concert. Many other entries will be exhibited inside the program/activity booklet. **Deadline for the entries is Mon. Nov. 1, 2021.**

Teachers should make copies of the reproducible violin outline for each student. The students will "design" a pattern and/or picture on the violin. The design should be 50% white and 50% black.

CONTEST RULES -*Entries that do not comply will be disqualified*

- Use 8'x11" **white paper with black ink** (sharpies work best)
- On the back in pencil (only)-print student name, age, school, and teacher's name – must be legible!
- Artwork must be executed by the student
